

School Sports Funding Impact report 2016-17

What is Sports Premium?

The government has provided additional funds each year to improve the provision for school sports. The funding has been jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport. The money goes directly to Headteachers to enable them to improve the quality of PE and sport for all children. At White House Academy, this means we received £8138 in the academic year 2016/17. Schools must spend this on improving their sports and PE provision, but can choose how to do this.
