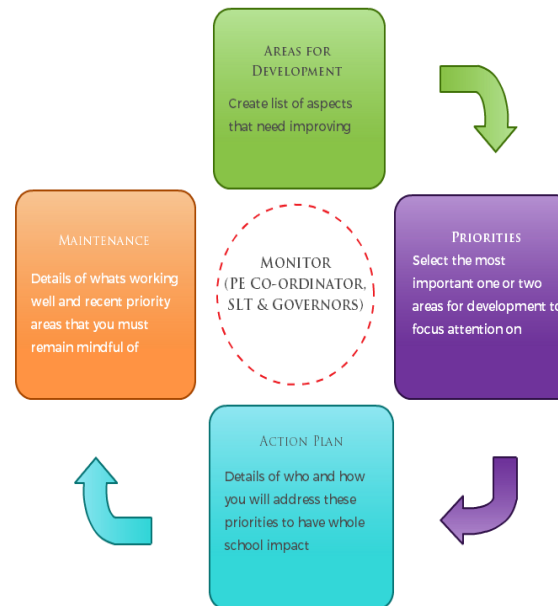


White House Academy Sports Funding 2018/19
