What is Sports Premium?

The government has provided additional funds each year to improve the provision for school sports. The funding has been jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport. The money goes directly to Headteachers to enable them to improve the quality of PE and sport for all children. At White House Academy, this means we received £17520 in the academic year 2016/17. Schools must spend this on improving their sports and PE provision, but can choose how to do this.

Team teaching	£8925	Specialist sports coach to work alongside our teachers 3 afternoons per week to deliver outstanding lessons and upskill staff.	Teachers state they feel more confident teaching PE – must continue to be embedded.
Improve active play in EYFS	£2100	Add playground markings to provide access to structured active play for EYFS children.	Children have used additional activity equipment during their focused learning activities.
Lunch time sport	£2040	Sports at lunch time, delivered by specialist sports coaches 3 days per week.	Children report they enjoy the activities provided by coaches.
