**Computing:** Taught as an integral part of the curriculum. Pupils are taught to use a variety of software and the internet to collect, analyse, evaluate and present data and information. Pupils are taught to use technology safely, respectfully and responsibility through termly online safety lessons.

**Music:** Pupils are taught to use their voices expressively through songs, chants and rhymes and to appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality music drawn from different traditions and from great composers and musicians.

**Art and Design / Design and Technology:** Pupils are taught elements of these subjects within the Text/Context curriculum where appropriate and relevant links can be made. Otherwise, this is taught discretely as part of dedicated curriculum weeks.

**PSHE:** The core themes pupils are taught are:

- Health and well-being including, physical and emotional safety, physical, emotional and mental health and loss
- Relationships including, respect, bullying, types of relationships, conflict resolution and diversity
- Living in the wider world including, rights and responsibilities, finance and enterprise, community and social media

**Languages:** Spanish is being taught within Year 4, plans to extend this delivery focusing on oral expression in all year groups are in place.
